Through the interactive voice response system, or IVR, Marietta Power and Water has the technology to respond quickly to outages, but we need your help.

To make sure that we restore your power as soon as possible, please verify that we have your correct phone number on file. The number that we have in our records also reflects your address. If the information is not current, there will be a delay in restoring your power. You will also not receive our standard follow-up

call letting you know that your power has been restored.

Verify your phone number by visiting our Web site at www.mariettopowerandwater.com. Click the Online Payments link and the Online Utility Customer Support screen will appear. If you have used this screen before, simply enter your Account ID as it appears on your statement and your PIN to view your account information. If you have never used the screen, click the Get PIN link to register your account. If your information needs updating, click the Email Us link to notify us of any changes.

GET PAID TO REPLACE YOUR TIRED APPLIANCES WITH NEW ENERGY STAR QUALIFIED MODELS THROUGH THE ENERGY EFFICIENT APPLIANCE REBATE PROGRAM

If you've been considering replacing your refrigerator, dishwasher or other large appliance, now is the ideal time. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 has appropriated funds to each state for appliance rebate programs, and Georgia residents have been allocated \$8,642,490 of the program money.

The objective of the initiative is to stimulate the economy by encouraging consumers to replace old appliances with new ENERGY STAR qualified models. Georgia residents who replace an existing appliance with a qualified appliance purchased after February 12, 2010, are eligible to apply for the rebate.

Residents may apply for one rebate per category per address up to \$1,200 total for one address, so you may want to replace more than one appliance.

Program participants are encouraged to apply early as the money is distributed on a

first-come first-served basis that ends when the funds have been depleted.
