Providing Safe, High Quality Water is Our Mission



Providing safe H₂O to the Marietta community is our number one priority. Marietta Power and Water purchases all of our water from the Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority (CCMWA). The CCMWA draws water from two sources, the Chattahoochee River and Lake Allatoona, then runs the water through a comprehensive treatment process. Once treated, the CCMWA sends it to the Marietta distribution system where it is delivered to homes and businesses throughout the community. Our water is constantly monitored for safety and quality both throughout the treatment process and once in the distribution system, undergoing testing for biological, inorganic, volatile organic and synthetic organic substances. Marietta Power and Water and CCMWA are both award winning utilities, CCMWA for their laboratory and treatment facilities and Marietta Power and Water for our distribution and wastewater collection system. It is our mission to ensure the citizens of Marietta have safe, high quality water with outstanding service.

A Dripping Faucet Can Add Up on Your Utility Bill

Even a small faucet leak can waste gallons of water, not to mention increasing your utility bill. A faucet that leaks even one drop per minute adds up

to 53 gallons of wasted water per year. A steady drip of 10 drops per minute wastes 539 gallons per year.

Using Water This Spring



The Georgia Water Stewardship Act allows daily outdoor watering for lawn and plant maintenance between the hours of 4 p.m. and 10 a.m. by anyone whose water is supplied by a water system permitted by the Environmental Protection Division.

The following outdoor water uses also are allowed daily at any time of the day by anyone:

- Irrigation of personal food gardens;
- Irrigation of new and replanted plant, seed, or turf in landscapes, golf courses, or sports turf fields during installation and for a period of 30 days immediately following the date of installation;
- Drip irrigation or irrigation using soaker hoses;
- Hand-watering with a hose with automatic cutoff or handheld container;

- Use of water withdrawn from private water wells or surface water by an owner or operator of property if such well or surface water is on said property;

Outdoor water use for any purposes other than watering of plants, such as power washing or washing cars, is still restricted to the current odd/even watering schedule.

- Odd-numbered addresses can water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.
- Even-numbered and unnumbered addresses can water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays.
