Increased Water Restrictions Are Now in Effect for 52 Counties

The Environmental Protection Division has issued a level 2 drought response for north Georgia, including all of Cobb and surrounding counties. Level 2 drought response limits outdoor watering to only two days a week on an odd/even schedule.

- Even-numbered addresses may water Wednesdays and Saturdays (4 p.m. to 10 a.m.).
- Odd-numbered addresses may water Thursdays and Sundays (4 p.m. to 10 a.m.).

Prohibited outdoor water uses include:

- Washing of hard surfaces such as streets and sidewalks
- Water for ornamental purposes, such as fountains
- The use of fire hydrants -- except for firefighting and public safety
- Non-commercial washing of vehicles
- Non-commercial pressure washing
- Fundraising car washes

The following activities are presently allowed under both a Level 1 or Level 2 drought response:

- Irrigation of personal food gardens may be done at any time during the day
- Irrigation of new and replanted plant, seed or turf may be done at any time of day for 30 days after installation

- Drip irrigation or irrigation using soaker hoses may be done at any time of day, and hand watering with a hose with automatic cutoff or handheld container may be done at any time of day
- General landscape watering may be done between 4 p.m. and 10 a.m. on the designated odd / even watering schedule

Have a Happy and Safe Holiday with These Holiday Decorating Tips

Twinkling lights and ornaments help capture the spirit of the holiday, but don't let your holiday season become dampened by a fire. Follow these simple tips to keep you and your family safe this holiday season:

- Choose a tree with fresh, green needles that do not fall off when touched.
- Check the intended use of any decorative lights you hang. Some lights are only for indoor or outdoor use, but not for both.
- Choose decorations that are flame resistant or flame retardant.
- Keep lit candles away from decorations and other things that can burn.
- Replace any string of lights with worn or broken cords or loose bulb connections.
- Check electrical extension cords for wear and make sure they are not running across doorways or under carpets. Extension cords are intended for temporary use.
- Always turn off Christmas tree lights before leaving home or going to bed.
