Be protected from **FLU** during fall and Winter



When is the best time to get the flu shot?

The flu season begins in October 2019 and ends in May 2020. If you receive the shot before the end of October, the immunity will protect you during the peak flu season.

Can I get sick from the flu shot?

The vaccine is made from an inactivated virus that can't transmit infection. It takes a week or two to get protection from the vaccine. People assume that because they got sick after getting the vaccine, the shot caused their illness.

Here's what you need to know:
