# Pay Your Bill the Easy way with Marietta Power and Water's E-Notification Program

Signing up for e-notification is easy. Simply logon to [www.mariettapowerandwater.com](http://www.mariettapowerandwater.com) and click the Online Payments button. This will take you to the Online Payment System portal where you will be able to Create an Account.

As an e-Notification subscriber, you will also automatically receive an e-mail message reminding you when your account balance includes charges from the previous month's billing and that the due date has passed on the most recent billing. This added convenience gives you another opportunity to pay your bill without interrupted service. To receive your PDF bill copy, log on to your account at [www.mariettapowerandwater.com](http://www.mariettapowerandwater.com) to access your billing history and get your printable bill copy! You can print an actual copy or just a summary statement.

# Follow These Simple Tips and Save on Your Energy Bill this Summer



- Consider taking cooler, shorter showers. Or, install a 2.5 gallon per-minute low-flow shower head that uses only about 25 gallons of water for a 10-minute shower.
- Use caulk and weather-stripping to seal cracks and gaps around windows, doors, plumbing and electrical outlets.
- Take advantage of the longer days of summer by utilizing natural sunlight as much as possible for indoor activities. At night, use task lighting when practical instead of overhead lighting.
- Replace incandescent light bulbs with Energy Star® qualified lighting that not only uses less energy, but also produces approximately 75 percent less heat than incandescent lighting.
- If you have a window unit, place it on the north side of the house where it is cooler. Shading your air conditioner from direct sunlight will make it work less, saving you energy.
- A full refrigerator helps it to maintain a cool temperature and not warm up so fast when the door is open. Keep food covered as moisture buildup makes the air inside the refrigerator harder to cool.
- Use the grill as often as possible to eliminate heating up the house.
