Rely on Budget Billing for Equal Payments Throughout the Year



Every once in a while, life can throw us off of our game. Fortunately, an inconsistent utility bill does not have to be one of those unanticipated expenses. With Marietta Power and Water's Budget Billing Program, you'll have the satisfaction of knowing your bill will be consistent each month.

To qualify, you must be a Marietta Power and Water residential customer, have been a customer in good standing for 12 months, and commit to the Budget Billing Program for a full 12-month period.

Your monthly budget billing amount is based on the average of your actual charges for the last 12 months. This average will be the set amount of your bill every month for 12 consecutive months. On your annual sign up date (12th bill), your account will be credited for any overpayment made or a charge for the difference owed will be reflected on that bill.

The application process is fast and easy. To sign up for budget billing, you can complete the online form on our web site. Visit www.mariettapowerandwater.com, and click on Online Forms under the Customer Service tab, then scroll down to Budget Billing and click on the form. Fill out the form and click submit. Program Your Thermostat for the Upcoming Cooler Temperatures

Fall is quickly approaching! Take control of your home's energy use with a programmable thermostat. A programmable thermostat adjusts your home's temperature based on settings you've designated for specific times of the day – instead of having the same temperature all day.

During the cooling season, program your thermostat to allow the temperature in your home to increase five to seven degrees while you are sleeping and while you are out for the day. During the heating season, allow the temperature in your home to decrease five to seven degrees while you are sleeping or are out for the day. Use ceiling fans in the summer and

extra clothes/blankets in the winter to stay comfortable. If you are leaving for several days, set the temperatures back even further.

Programmable thermostats help minimize energy consumption by making sure your home's heating and cooling systems are working hard only when necessary.
