Great Ways to Save Money This Holiday Season

The holiday season is a great time to reconnect with friends and family, and it can also be a great time to save on energy costs. Here are a few money-saving tips that you can implement to lower energy bills this holiday season and into the new year.

- Change old bulbs around your house to high-efficiency LEDs. ENERGY STAR® certified LED decorative light strings use 75 percent less energy than standard incandescent lights and last up to 10 times longer.
- Install a timer to automatically turn lights on at dusk and off late at night or when you are not home.
- When serving up the holiday feast, use an energy-efficient microwave for small tasks whenever possible. When cleaning up, run the dishwasher only when you have a full load.
- It takes the same amount of energy to operate a full oven as it does an almost empty one, so try to cook as many dishes as possible at the same time. Also, when possible, keep lids on pots – food cooks faster and you use less energy.
- Extra bodies in the house can also mean extra heat. Turn down the thermostat in your house just before your guests arrive.

You can also save energy all year long with a programmable thermostat. Some smart thermostat models are self-programming and come with a remote control and an app for your phone.
