Use these Energy-Saving Tips to Keep You and Your Family Warm and Comfortable This Winter

High winter heating bills can really impact your monthly budget. Here are few simple tips that can help you start saving immediately.

- Inspect the ductwork in your attic and crawlspace to ensure it has not become obstructed or disconnected.
- A clean furnace runs more efficiently, so change your furnace filter on a monthly basis.
- Open window shades and draperies during the day and let the sun warm your home.
- When you're not using your fireplace, make sure to close the damper.
- Caulk and use weather stripping to prevent air leaks around windows and doors.
- Force warm air near the ceiling down by reversing the direction of ceiling fans.

Here are a few more ideas that require a little more effort. The energy savings may be well worth the time

and money needed to implement these tips.

- Programmable thermostats can be set to automatically lower the temperature at night while you are sleeping and during times when you and your family are usually away from home.
- Hire a professional heating contractor and ask them to check your heating equipment, test ductwork, and seal leaks.

Rely on BUDGET BILLING for Equal Utility Payments Throughout the Year

If you're looking for a better way to stabilize your monthly energy bill, then Marietta Power and Water's Budget Billing Program is perfect for you. You'll have the peace of mind knowing your bill will be consistent each month.

To qualify, you must be a Marietta Power and Water residential customer, have been a customer in good standing for 12 months, and commit to the Budget Billing Program for a full 12-month period.

Your monthly budget billing amount is based on the average of your actual charges for the last 12 months. This average will be the set amount of your bill every month for 12 consecutive months.

On your annual sign up date (12th bill), your account will be credited for any overpayment made or a charge for the difference owed will be reflected on that bill.

To sign up for budget billing, you can complete the online form on our website. Visit www.mariettapowerandwater.com, click on Online Forms under the Customer Service tab, then scroll down to Budget Billing and click on the form. Fill out the form and click submit.
