VERIFY YOUR PHONE NUMBER TO ENSURE FASTER SERVICE DURING POWER OUTAGES

To ensure your electrical service is restored as quickly as possible during a power outage, Marietta Power and Water recommends you verify your current phone number. If the information is not current, there may be a delay in restoring your power and you will not receive an optional follow-up call letting you know your power has been restored. Verifying that we have your current phone number on file is fast and simple:

1. If you're already a subscriber to Marietta Power and Water's Online services, simply login to your account and verify that your phone number is correct. If your phone number is not correct, click the Email Us link to notify us of any changes.

2. If you are new to our Online services, you can sign up at www.mariettapowerandwater.com. Once you are on the Home page:
 - Click "Online Payments" in the blue navigation boxes on the right side of the website.
 - When you reach the Account Login page, click Create Account.
 - You will need your account number and cycle/route number from your statement to complete this quick process. If your information needs updating, click the Email Us link to notify us of any changes.

Simple Ways to Save Energy this Winter

Check out these low-cost ways to save energy and money this winter.

- **Find and seal leaks.** If you feel cold air coming from your windows and doorways, you may have tiny leaks.
- **Consider a programmable thermostat.** During cold weather, set your thermostat as low as is comfortable when you are at home during waking hours. Reducing the heat by only a few degrees when you are sleeping or out of the house will help save money.
- **Change your furnace filter regularly.** A dirty furnace filter will slow the air flow through your HVAC system, making the system work harder to heat your home. Also, consider an annual tune-up each winter to make sure your system is running efficiently.
- **Take advantage of sunlight.** Naturally heat your home by opening curtains on

south-facing windows during the day. Close curtains at night to protect your home from losing heat. Or, consider purchasing insulated curtains that will help block the cold air.

- **Reduce water heating costs.** Reduce the temperature of your water heater to 120 degrees Fahrenheit. Or, consider installing a tankless water heater that heats water as needed, saving money in the long run.
- **Consider a ductless mini-split heating system.** If the heating is uneven throughout the house, a ductless mini-split heating system allows you to control the temperature in individual rooms or spaces. It's easy to install and is energy-efficient.
