Safe Drinking Water is Our Mission

At Marietta Power and Water, our constant goal is to provide you with safe and a dependable supply of drinking water at a reasonable cost. When it comes to water, one of the most critical aspects is to ensure that it meets all federal and state drinking water standards established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) and the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD).


High quality, safe drinking water is critical to the physical and economic health of our community. Achieving and maintaining water quality through the treatment and delivery of safe drinking water is an intricate and complex process. Each year, we compile an annual Water Quality Report with data describing our ongoing evaluation of your drinking water quality. We hope that by providing you with this report, we will impart confidence in the safety and quality of your drinking water.

Marietta Power and Water's new Water Quality Report is now available on our website(see URL below) and contains details of the drinking water testing that was performed between January 1 and December 31, 2022. Our water is continually monitored for quality control and assurance, both at the treatment plant and in the distribution system. Thousands of water samples are taken and tested each year to monitor for substances such as pesticides; herbicides; and microbial, organic, and inorganic contaminants. This monitoring, once again, confirms your water supply meets or exceeds all state and federal drinking water standards.

"Our staff continues to work hard every day — at any hour — to deliver the highest quality drinking water without interruption. This report meets the federal Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) requirements for the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) and contains information on the source of our water, its components, and the health risks associated with any contaminants," said Tim Marshall, Marietta Power and Water's Environmental Compliance Coordinator.
