Prepare for Cooler Weather Temperatures

Fall is the perfect time to finish any home maintenance projects as well as prepare for colder weather.

Here are a few easy ways you can prepare your home for winter:

1. Check your home's heating and air conditioning system. Change your filters and consider having your system inspected by a reputable HVAC company.
2. Caulk around windows and doors. Inspect the trim around your windows and doors and look for any cracks. If you see cracks, scrape away any bad caulk and apply fresh caulk. Using a caulk gun will ensure you fill any gaps and get a clean line.
3. Once the leaves have fallen from the trees, take time to clean your gutters. Clogged gutters can lead to roof rot and foundation problems.
4. Test your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors. Check your smoke detectors to make sure they are working and have good batteries. If your home lacks carbon monoxide detectors, consider installing some.
5. Perform a quick energy audit. We offer all the tools you need to perform an energy audit on your entire home, including space heaters, heat pumps, and more.

Outdoor Watering for Fall

Cooler temperatures signal a new growing season and a new opportunity to maximize water consumption. By using water smartly, you can enjoy a beautiful lawn and bountiful garden throughout fall and early winter — without increasing your water bill.

Here are a few simple ways you can accomplish both:

- Adjust your lawn mower to a higher setting. A taller lawn holds moisture better than a shorter lawn.
- Avoid watering on windy days when most water will blow away or evaporate.
- Check your sprinkler system for leaks and broken sprinkler heads and repair promptly.
- Adjust sprinkler heads to prevent overspray onto sidewalks or roadways.
- Consider using a soaker hose instead of a sprinkler. Soaker hoses are more efficient and disperse water directly into the ground with less run-off.
- Aerate your lawn at least once a year so water can reach the roots and doesn't lay on the surface.
- Water container plants thoroughly until water seeps from drainage holes. Thorough watering encourages deep roots resulting in less frequent watering needs and apply water directly to the soil instead of showering foliage.
- Use a layer of mulch on the surface of your planting beds to retain moisture and minimize weed growth which competes for water.
- Consider skipping watering for a day if there has been a good rain.
