

COUNCIL BILL NO. 256686

ORDINANCE NO. 4522

AN ORDINANCE

Amending Ordinance No. 4022, in part, which adopted a new retirement plan for the employees of the City of Marietta, by eliminating Level 1 classification for employees and amending said plan so as to provide that all new employees shall be classified as Level 2 employees.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 4022 which adopted a new retirement plan for the employees of the City of Marietta, Georgia, is hereby amended by deleting Article III, Section 2 in its entirety and inserting a new Article III, Section 2 as follows:

"Article III, Section 2. Eligible employees. The following employees that are not excluded by Article III, Section 1, shall qualify for participation by meeting the pertinent requirements set forth in Article III, Section 3.

LEVEL 2 - Permanent policemen and firemen and all other full time employees, and elected and appointed members of the governing authority that are hired or commence service with the City of Marietta after the effective date of this Ordinance shall be considered Level 2 employees for all purposes under the retirement plan. Any employees that were hired or commenced service with the City of Marietta prior to the effective date of this Ordinance shall not be affected by this Ordinance."

Section 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not effect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the Mayor subject to Georgia Laws 1983, Page 4119.
