Virtual Inspections

We are pleased to be able to offer a virtual inspection program on certain fire safety inspections. Requests for a virtual inspection will require the requester to use the Microsoft Teams platform on a portable device such as a smartphone or tablet with access to both the device's camera and microphone.

To request a virtual inspection for a permit-based inspection, login to SagesGov and schedule an inspection as usual. In the notes to the inspector, request a virtual inspection. If the inspection is for existing building fire safety compliance, the inspector will make contact to arrange an inspection.

The inspector will email you a link to begin the Microsoft Teams Meeting at the appointed time. If the requester is more than five (5) minutes late to the virtual inspection appointment, it will be marked "disapproved," subject to reinspection fees, and will have to be rescheduled.

Throughout the inspection, the inspector will discuss with and direct the requester to point the camera to various elements to be inspected. The inspector may take screen shots in lieu of photos during the inspection. If for some reason the inspection cannot be completed virtually it will have to be done live.

At the conclusion of the inspection, a report of inspection will still be delivered to the inspection contact by email through our system.

Inspections that can be easily performed virtually:

- Fire 100% for NFPA 13D systems
- Fire 100% on a Limited-Work Construction Permit
- Small Space Tenant Move-in Inspections
- Food Trucks – Fire Safety Operating Permit
- Tents
- Special Event/Floor Plan/Access Control modifications
- Follow-up visits for fire safety compliance items
