

COUNCIL BILL NO. 312990ORDINANCE NO. 4817

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING Section 4-3003 of the Marietta City Code regarding the payment of cost of hospitalization insurance for employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA THAT:

Section 1: Deleting the wording of Section 4-3003 in its entirety to read as follows:

"Section 4-3003: Payment of cost of health, life and accidental death and dismemberment insurance for employees

Employees eligible for health, life and accidental death and dismemberment insurance benefits shall include: 1) all full time employees as defined as those individuals who work a minimum of 30 hours per week, including classified and appointed personnel; and, 2) the Mayor and City Council Members.

The City of Marietta shall pay 100% of the calculated premium cost of the health, life, and accidental death and dismemberment insurance on all eligible employees as defined above.

If an eligible employee chooses dependent health insurance coverage, the City of Marietta shall pay 80% of the calculated premium cost for dependent coverage of any City sponsored health insurance plan that the employee selects.

These contribution percentages may change based upon the financial ability of the City. Any change in contribution rate will be made in ordinance form."


Section 2: It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the Mayor, subject to Georgia laws 1983, page 4119.
