Re: Marietta Water – Sugar Hill Tank Construction Project

To whom it may concern,

Marietta Water will be replacing the existing elevated water tank on Sugar Hill Drive. The existing tank has reached the end of its service life. In addition, the capacity of the tank is being increased to accommodate growth and improve available emergency firefighting water volumes in the Sugar Hill service area. Construction activities are expected to begin in August 2022 and continue through early 2024.

Due to construction activities, there are likely to be periodic inconveniences experienced by those who live or travel through this area such as noise, traffic disruptions, access to Lewis Park, or other construction related activities. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience and ask for your understanding and patience as we attempt to make this vital improvement to the water system. The new water tank will provide safe drinking water and fire protection to residents and businesses for decades to come. Every reasonable effort will be made to minimize negative impacts to the community.
