Application Requirements:

All applications must be complete and include necessary support materials to effectively explain the proposed work. This may include paint colors, materials, photographs, renderings, site plans, etc.

Application Representation:

The applicant or any other party may appear on his/her own behalf or be represented by an agent or attorney at the public hearing to support the application.

Building Permit Requirements:

In addition to a COA application, building permits must be acquired from the Public Works Department. Building permits will not be issued without proof of an approved COA.

Deadline for Project Completion:

An approved certificate of approval must be implemented by the issuance of a building permit (when required by this Code) and the commencement of substantial and ongoing construction within a period of 12 months from the date of approval and if the issuance of a building permit (when required by this Code) and the substantial and ongoing construction is not so commenced, the certificate shall expire at the end of the 12-month period.

Design Guidelines

This document should be used by property owners, occupants, developers, and architects when considering any construction projects within a historic district. By consulting the guidelines first, designers will ensure compliance with the goals of the Marietta Historic Board of Review. - Sketches of sign with dimensions
- Photograph/sketch of sign location

New Construction and/or Additions:

- Site Plan
- Architectural Elevations
- Description of Materials
- Photographs of proposed site, adjoining properties and structures

Demolition:

- Photographs of structures
