## YEAR IN REVIEW

- Money allocated for station improvements
- \$3M for improvements to the Public Safety Training Center
- Money allocated for improved EMS Service delivery — new LUCAS devices; new Zoll-X cardiac monitor/defibrillators; new Stryker stair chairs
- Upgraded Knox Box infrastructure throughout the city at no cost to property owners.
- Implemented a mandatory third party reporting system for fire and life safety systems using IROL, LLC.
- New iPads in service on all units for in field reporting.
- Received new multi-gas detection monitors for all engines
- The MFD Community Paramedicine (CP) team assisted with 11 referrals from crews resulting from 911 dependence, social welfare issues, mental health concerns.
- The recruitment and retention working group developed great marketing and media presence
- The Fire Marshal's Office investigated and cleared 310 referrals from crews, ensuring the safety of the public in our buildings.
