### YEAR IN REVIEW

- The Fire Marshal's Office investigated and cleared 162 referrals from crews, ensuring the safety of the public in our buildings.
- Training— HazMat Drill; Technical Rescue Drill; Fireground Scenario; Live Fire; Hoarder Search Drill; 9 hands on medical drills; Acting Officer course; Fire Officer 1 course; two Relief Driver courses; two Advanced Relief Driver courses; FFE and LT promotional testing
- Initial Education/Training—Firefighter 1 course/exam; Firefighter 2 exam; EMT course; AEMT course
- Onboarded 25 new members (including 3 laterals from other agencies); said farewell to 23 members
- Promotions—1 new Deputy Chief of Operations; 2 new Asst. Chiefs; 3 new Lieutenants; 4 new Firefighter-Engineers
