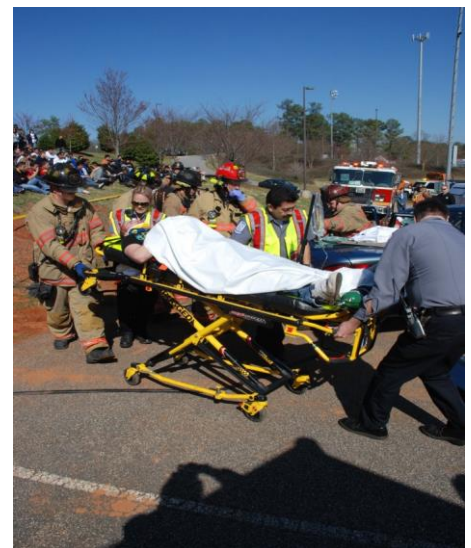

## What happens after the test?

**TEST RESULTS:** You will be notified by email of the results of your test (pass or fail) and rank order of passing candidates. Background booklets will be mailed out to the highest scoring candidates. Please be prepared to provide notarized criminal/ credit history release forms and copies of driver's history, birth certificate, high school or college diploma, and DD Form 214 (if applicable).

**BACKGROUND CHECK:** Top applicants will be reviewed and ranked by Fire Department Personnel.

**AGILITY TEST:** Candidates who successfully complete the background check will be scheduled for an agility and flexibility test.

**FITNESS TEST:** Candidates who successfully complete the agility test will be scheduled for a fitness test.

**INTERVIEW WITH THE CHIEF:** Recommended candidates will have a personal interview with the Chief. The Chief will then rank candidates accordingly.

**OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT:** The Fire Department will make an offer of employment if the candidate has successfully completed all prior requirement and a vacancy exists. This is a conditional offer of employment and is contingent upon the successful completion of the remaining evaluations.

**MEDICAL EVALUATION & DRUG SCREEN:** Individuals given a conditional offer of employment will be scheduled for a medical evaluation and drug screen.

**POLYGRAPH:** A polygraph is administered to verify information provided.

**PSYCHOLOGICAL:** A three-hour written assessment will be given by the Fire Department which is followed by a one-hour interview with a psychologist the following week.

**HIRED:** Successful candidates are fitted for uniforms, issued rules & regulations, and scheduled for New Hire Orientation. After graduating the 13-week recruit training, firefighters are assigned a shift and evaluated for a one-year working test period.
